8/18/4	Planning 4.1 To consider current planning applications:- 4.1.1. DC/18/1363/TCA - Trees in a Conservation Area Notification - (i) 1no. Sycamore and 1no. Apple (T1 and T2 on plan) - fell; (ii) 1no. Apple (T3 on plan) - Currently 5 metres tall with a 4 metre spread. Contains a large amount of advantageous shoot due to previously being over pruned, size and shape is not conducive to fruit production or picking. The crown of the tree to be thinned by removal of 60% of these advantageous shoots and a further 15% of the crown to be removed from the internal, inward growing branches. Due to the overall size of the crown, our client would like the height reduced by up to 2 metres on the vertical branches and up to 1.5 metres on the horizontal branches over the whole of the crown, providing the one third, two third ratio of pruning cuts can be maintained; (iii) Group of Crab Apples (G4 on plan) - reduce overhang on boundary back to suitable growth points.
